ADDENDUM B TO THE CORRECTED AGREEMENT OF COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT

Plaintiffs and CertainTeed hereby agree to the following addendum to the Corrected Agreement of Compromise and Settlement (“Settlement Agreement”):

If the Settlement Fund has not been exhausted following the expiration of the Claims Submission Period, the Claims Submission Period will remain open for as long as there are remaining funds. The Claims Administrator will continue to accept claims from Settlement Class Members until the Settlement Fund is exhausted. Settlement Class Members who submit Eligible Claims during this extended period of time will receive a one-time payment for their claim according to the proration schedule in Section 7.2(c) of the Settlement Agreement, up to the point the Settlement Fund is exhausted. The Claims Administrator will pay claims in the order in which they are received after the end of the Claims Submission Period, until the Settlement Fund is exhausted.
